Inez Baker Mayfield passed away on August 19, 2014. She was born to the late Lettie Merritt and William Henry Baker on August 1, 1921 in Franklin County Georgia. She was the youngest of ten children, all of whom have preceded her in death. She attended school in the Davie County School System. In 1970 she proudly received her Nursing Assistant and Home Care for the Aged Certificate from Davidson County Community College. Inez retired from Autumn Care of Mocksville after thirty-five years of service. After her retirement, she used her training as a home health care provider with the Davie County CAP program. She was a faithful member of Shiloh Baptist Church where she used her many talents and skills. She was the president of the Chancel Choir, a member of the Spiritual Choir, the Senior Missionary Department, Pastor's Aide, Deaconess Board, and Head of the Social Committee.
